The CDC estimates that it costs society \$831,000 per case to address child abuse over the lifetime of the child. Family Compass saves the community millions of dollars each year by keeping hundreds of children out of the overburdened CPS system, most importantly preventing the trauma of child abuse and neglect. The





agency enters the lives of vulnerable children atrisk for abuse, and provides their parents with mentoring, education, support, and tools to aid them in becoming stronger, healthier families. Your gift provides for either diapers for a child whose parent(s) is in the Dallas County Jail or a training session for parents in the Dallas County Jail.

Did you know 1 in 9 adults in the U.S. is an alcoholic? There are over 650,000 alcoholics located in the Dallas-Fort Worth area alone. The Magdalen



House focuses on providing a safe, supportive environment for individuals to recover from alcoholism. They believe that every alcoholic person, regardless of their resources, deserves the opportunity to recover. The Magdalen House provides free, gender specific, peer implemented services 365 days a year. Your gift can provide coffee, creamer, sweetener, and cups for the clients attending Support Group meetings.

The Magdalen House is a nonprofit organization helping individuals achieve sobriety and sustain recovery from alcoholism at no cost and based on 12-Step spiritual principles. MHCC BECOMING BELOVED ASYLUM HOSPITALITY

War. Gangs. Pervasive harassment or discrimination. Corruption. Sexual violence. Humanitarian crises in countries worldwide force thousands of people to leave home in search of safety for themselves or their children. Many seek asylum in the United States.

Midway Hills CC is offering radical hospitality to migrants from various countries. Several lesser-used rooms in the church have been converted to a sleeping dorm and living

spaces. Because of the difficulties of claiming asylum and an extreme delay in work authorization by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services, the hospitality stay adds up to 12 weeks of support. Your gift helps provide for weekly groceries, cell phone, a pair of jeans and shoes, and a backpack for an individual staying at the church.
